  - (d) Bring out the significance of the character of Eliza Doolittle in *Pygmalion*.
  
2. Explain any **one** in about 200 words, with reference to the context. 5×1=5
  - (a) “Irreparable is the loss; and patience  
Says it is past her cure.”
  - (b) “If u can’t appreciate what you’ve got, you’d better get what you can appreciate.”
  - (c) “Happy is the man who can make a living by his hobby.”
  - (d) “How beauteous mankind is! O brave new world,  
That has such people in’t!  
Is, I know how to curse?”
  
3. Answer any **two** of the following questions: 2×2 = 4
  - (a) What is the play *Pygmalion* named after?
  - (b) What bet does Pickering make with Higgins? Why?
  - (c) Why do you think that Shakespeare begins *The Tempest* with a storm?
  - (d) Describe very briefly, what the epilogue of *The Tempest* tells us.
  
4. Write short notes on any **two** of the following literary terms: 5×2=10  
Catharsis, Hamartia, Chorus, Exposition, Comic-relief, Irony, Three Unities.
  
5. Write a short composition on any **one** of the following topics: 16×1=16
  - (a) Environmental Pollution
  - (b) Merits of Social Media
  - (c) Impact of the Covid-19 Lockdown.
